

## Gas Meter Relocation Information Sheet

During the design process, the design team has met with utilities regarding utility relocations. After discussions with the gas company (Atmos Energy), it became apparent that nearly half of the gas meters adjacent to 127th Street would require relocation to the houses. Atmos Energy informed the City that when relocating the meters, Kansas law requires that houses be inspected for natural gas code violations prior to hooking up service. If violations are found, the gas company cannot reconnect service until the violations are corrected. To avoid having 127th Street residents without service, the city is implementing the following process:

- Residents will be contacted to schedule an inspection of their natural gas service. The inspector will need access to the inside of the homes.
- After inspections are complete, the city will notify all residents that received inspections if they have any natural gas code violations. Affected residents will receive additional instructions at this time.
- The city will work with affected residents to find a solution to the natural gas code violations.
- Once all natural gas code violations are fixed, Atmos Energy will proceed with relocating gas meters.
